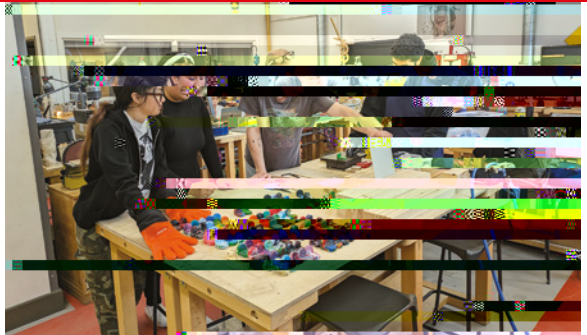

CASE STUDY:

Reimagining disused community spaces

The Kilburn Lab initiative, led by the School of Arts and supported by the London Boroughs of Brent and Camden, reimagines disused community spaces to improve North London neighbourhoods through 44 major projects run by our creative students. Our Interior Architecture and Design students support community groups to develop their spaces and built a scale model of Kilburn High Street to assist with a Local Authority consultation exercise. This has helped local people, community organisations and businesses have a say over the strategic direction of high streets. Our students also curated the Kilburn Museum Lab, to celebrate the area's hidden stories and people's wishes for the future of Kilburn.
